OPEN DAY

STEP ONE:

The application process

- Complete Special Programme Class application (if applicable)
- Make appointment for enrolment interview
- Copy of birth certificate/passport
- Zone Eligibility
- Out of Zone Ballot Applications Close 2.00pm:
Thursday 27th October

STEP TWO:

Interviews

STEP THREE:

Enrolment confirmation

All students residing with whānau or primary caregivers or legal guardians in the Trident zone are automatically eligible to attend Trident.

Out of the zone applications

Parents will be notified of the Out of Zone ballot acceptance in the second week of Term 4.

Academic Extension and Support Programmes

Confirmation of acceptance for all Extension and Support Programmes is Term 4, from **1st December**.

Out of Zone information

Students residing with parents, caregivers or legal guardians outside the Trident High School Zone are considered to be out-of-zone. Dependent on the number of students enrolling for 2023 the THS BOT will recommend the number of out-of-zone students who will be able to attend through a ballot process.

The Enrolment Scheme and associated Zone directed by the Ministry of Education continues for 2023. A copy of the scheme is on the website. On the Application to Enrol form you must indicate whether it is an in-zone or out-of-zone enrolment. If it is an out-of-zone-application you must also indicate which category you wish to enrol in (see right for categories).

NOTE: Legislation requires the selection to be carried out by ballot. See below for ballot categories, categories are in order of preference.

Category 1	Special Programmes
Category 2	Applicants who are siblings of current students
Category 3	Applicants who are siblings of former students
Category 4	Applicants who are children of former students.
Category 5	Applicants who are children of board employees or board members
Category 6	All other applicants
